

Tenth Annual Goodes Prize Frequently Asked Questions

GENERAL

When and where is the Tenth Annual Goodes Prize?

The Tenth Annual Goodes Prize will take place in Stockholm, Sweden over the course of three days. The schedule of events is:

Sunday, September 8, 2024

Welcome Reception Grand Hotel, Stockholm, Sweden 6:30-8:30pm CET

Monday, September 9, 2024

Scientific Lecture Series (featuring our past Goodes Prize winners) Karolinska Institute 8:00am – 4:00pm CET

Tuesday, September 10, 2024

Goodes Prize Dinner Stockholm City Hall 6:00-10:00pm CET

What day should I arrive in Stockholm?

We encourage all attendees to arrive the morning of September 8 so that you can join us for all the scheduled events. All attendees are responsible for arranging their own flights.

What airport should I fly to?

Arlanda International Airport.

Where should I stay while in Stockholm?

The ADDF recommends the following hotels. All hotels listed are less than a 15-minute car ride to the Karolinska Institute and a 5-10-minute drive (or about a 20-minute walk to City Hall). All attendees are responsible for making their own hotel arrangements and we encourage you to book early.

How long does it take to get from the airport to The Grand Hotel or nearby hotels? It takes approximately 35 - 40 minutes in a cab (pending traffic). All cabs take credit cards.

Is Uber available in Stockholm?

Yes. Uber is available in Stockholm. Cabs are also available outside of most hotels or hotels can call a cab for you. The preferred cab service is: <u>Taxi Stockholm</u>

Do I need a Visa to visit Stockholm?

No. US residents do not need a Visa to visit Stockholm. Passports are required.

Does my ticket grant me access to the welcome reception, scientific lecture series, and the Goodes Prize dinner?

Yes. All table and ticket purchasers are invited to the welcome reception, scientific lecture series and Goodes Prize dinner <u>with the exception of the Bronze ticket</u>. If you registered for a Bronze ticket that grants you access <u>ONLY</u> to the scientific lecture series on September 9, 2024.

Should I get Swedish Krona's for my trip?

It is not necessary to have cash in Stockholm. All businesses take credit cards and many of them no longer accept cash.

What is the weather like in Stockholm in September?

In September, the average high is around 56 degrees with it getting cooler at night. We suggest packing clothes for temperatures between 50-60 degrees, but also suggest checking weather apps before leaving.

Do you have tourist recommendations for Stockholm?

Yes! We recommend visiting the following:

- 1. <u>Djurgården</u> Stockholmers are obsessed with nature, and nowhere is better than Djurgården's tranquil waterside and woodland trails. If you're into art and history, this island also boasts several of the capital's most significant museums. At the openair Skansen, stroll through five centuries of Swedish houses and farmsteads and observe wild Nordic animals. The Vasa Museum is home to a giant 17th-century salvaged ship, while ABBA: The Museum combines nostalgic memorabilia with quirky interactive exhibits. And choruses, obviously. (About a 20-minute walk from The Grand Hotel or nearby hotels)
- 2. Old Town (Gamla Stan) One of the largest tourist attractions in Stockholm, Old Town (Gamla Stan) is Stockholm's original city centre and consists of Stadsholmen island and the islets of Riddarholmen, Helgeandsholmen and Strömsborg. (About a 5-10 minute walk from The Grand Hotel or nearby hotels)
- 3. <u>City Hall Tour</u> The Stockholm City Hall is one of Sweden's most famous buildings, and one of the capital's most visited tourist attractions. It houses offices for 200 people including the Municipal Council, and is also famous for its grand ceremonial halls and unique art pieces. The Stockholm City Hall is the venue of the Nobel Prize banquet (and the Goodes Prize dinner!). (About a 20-25 minute walk from The Grand Hotel or nearby hotels)
- 4. The Royal Palace The palace is the workplace of The King and Queen, and of the offices that are included in the Royal Court. The Royal Palace is a combination of royal residence, workplace and cultural-historical monument, and is open all year round to visitors. (About a 5-10 minute walk from The Grand Hotel or nearby hotels.)
- 5. <u>Drottingholm Palace</u> Drottningholm Palace is on UNESCO's World Heritage list. It is the most well-preserved royal castle built in the 1600s in Sweden and at the same time is representative of all European architecture for the period. (*Boats depart from City Hall daily or you can go on a tour. This is a full day trip*)
- 6. Sail through the 30,000-island Archipelago While Stockholm's city skyline is jaw-droppingly beautiful, the wider region's jewel-in-the-crown is its dazzling archipelago, spilling out into the Baltic Sea. Here you'll find thousands of islands, ranging from chic tourist spots boasting boutique hotels and sandy beaches, to deserted rocky outposts sprouting with pine trees. (Tours are offered daily. You can book the same day or in advance. Booking sites are right across the street from The Grand Hotel or you can book online.)

TENTH ANNUAL GOODES PRIZE DINNER

When and where does the Tenth Annual Goodes Prize Dinner take place?

The dinner will take place on September 10, 2024, from 6-10pm at City Hall, Stockholm. Cocktails will be held in the <u>Blue Hall</u> from 6:00 – 7:00pm and dinner will be held in the <u>Golden Hall</u>.

The Nobel Peace Prize dinner takes place at City Hall annually!

What is the attire for the Goodes Prize Dinner on September 10, 2024? Black tie.

Who is this year's Goodes Prize recipient?

This year's Goodes Prize recipient is <u>Henrik Zetterberg</u>, <u>MD</u>, <u>PhD</u> who is a pioneer in the Alzheimer's space, spending the last 15+ years focusing on the development of biomarkers for Alzheimer's and other neurodegenerative diseases.

Will cabs be available after the event?

Yes. The ADDF will make sure to have several cabs available after dinner to take guests back to their hotels. Guests are responsible for transportation to the event.
