Since our founding in 1998, the ADDF has invested over \$80 million to support over 500 programs across 18 countries.

Our Strategy

Our in-house team of expert neuroscientists finds and funds drug discovery projects that have the best chance of preventing or treating Alzheimer's. Drug discovery is a chronically underfunded area, so our investments mean good ideas get explored. And every idea is a chance at a cure.

The ADDF's commitment to accelerating Alzheimer's drug discovery is comprehensive. We organize conferences across the U.S. and overseas so the field can share findings and expertise, and we built ADDF ACCESS to help scientists get the services they need as the scope of their research increases.

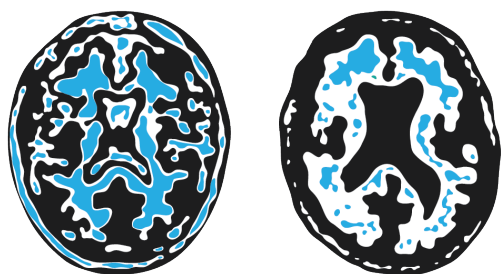
